## Covid-19 vaccination clinic

On April 19th, we hosted a Covid-19 information and vaccination clinic. We provided people with answers to their vaccine questions so that they could make an informed decision. Thirty people experiencing barriers received their vaccine ! Thank you Chatham-Kent Public Health for making this possible.
